Treatments available:

- Intravenous access, flushing, and dressing changes (PICCS, portacaths, and other central lines)
- Chemotherapy
- Infusions such as: Blood transfusions, other blood products, platelets; magnesium, potassium; steroids; venofer; feraheme and antibiotics
- Injections such as Avanesp, procrit, sandostation
- IVIG
- Reclast
- Tysabri infusions
- Other treatments per Doctors request
